Description of Course:

Prep Junior: Our junior ballet programme introduces our little ballerinas to basic ballet technique while developing imagination, co-ordination, posture and confidence with beautiful props and music being incorporated into each class. Later in the term we introduce slightly more advanced ballets steps and routines. We use correct french ballet terms from 'demi-plie' and 'sautes' to positions of the arms etc and we focus on introducing a beautiful ballet posture in our ballerinas. Students also learn the RAD pre-primary examination syllabus.

Prep Senior & up: In our graded level classes we introduce ballet techniques, steps and exercises that are age appropriate in their technical requirements. From the ages of 6+ yrs students also study the Royal Academy of Dance (RAD) system of ballet examinations and have the option of entering for RAD ballet exams. The aim of our graded classes is to build beautiful posture and ballet technique in our students while continuing to develop their knowledge of ballet steps and their individual sense of performance and selfexpression. The benefits of a weekly ballet class shows in the development of graceful posture. Their confidence and self-esteem also builds from dancing individually in class, in examinations and in front of their families and friends on our recital days.



All technique, theory, musicianship and repertoire including orchestra pieces (if necessary) will be covered.

Music in the early stages can be quite solitary until the beginner stage is passed. After this the children can join orchestras etc. where they can make new friends whilst improving their music skills and it is at this point where they can really have fun with their music. While the exam system can be very helpful in pushing the student forward with technique and thus providing a goal to aim for, exams are not for everyone and are not compulsory. Whether your child does exams or not, I accompany all students on the piano every week so that they can 'stick' to their own parts while listening to a different part a the same time. This ensures that the student is very well prepared to play at exams or in orchestras etc. and as I accompany all my own students at exams there is no need to look outside for an accompanist.
