



## MAMJS 'Maths Eyes' Photo Competition 2023

### What is 'MAMJS Maths Eyes' competition?

Every year during Maths Week, the *Maths Eyes* team runs a photo competition, with categories for all ages. This year MAMJS aim to submit as many entries as our 'Maths Eyes' can see! All MAMJS students, from Montessori – 6<sup>th</sup> Class, are eligible to enter the competition (under their relevant age category). The winners of the national competition under each category will be announced in February 2024.

### What does a 'Maths Eyes' competition entry look like?

- Look around in your own environment.
- Take a picture and tell us what your maths eyes see? (high resolution photo required)
- You can annotate your picture if it helps tell your story if you wish. You can load a tagline separately on the form.
- You must use your own photo that has been taken (stock photos or downloaded images are not permitted).
- You need the permission of anyone recognisable in the photos.

### How do I submit my entry?

- Take a photo of something that you've seen with your 'Maths Eyes'. Copy it on to a word document (or PowerPoint, etc.) and include a 'tag line' or 'maths question' that relates to your photo.
- Please email your photo, including your tagline (or 'maths question') to [gbeatty@mountanvillemjs.ie](mailto:gbeatty@mountanvillemjs.ie)
- The competition will run until **Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November**.
- In the main body of the email, please include the following;
  - ✓ Student's name
  - ✓ Class & teacher
  - ✓ Age (on date of submission)
- **Please note:** All entries must be submitted via email, so that they can be successfully submitted to the competition. Ms Beatty can print and display the entries received around our school, so students don't need to bring a hard copy of their entry to school.

### Where can I find further information and inspiration?

Please email your submission directly to Ms Beatty. Ms Beatty will submit all MAMJS entries directly to the national competition by the end of November, ensuring all formatting fits the criteria within each age category. We look forward to viewing our school corridors over the coming weeks through the lens of our 'Maths Eyes'!
